The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) is presenting preliminary plans and information for the S.R. 422 Bridge Replacement Project. 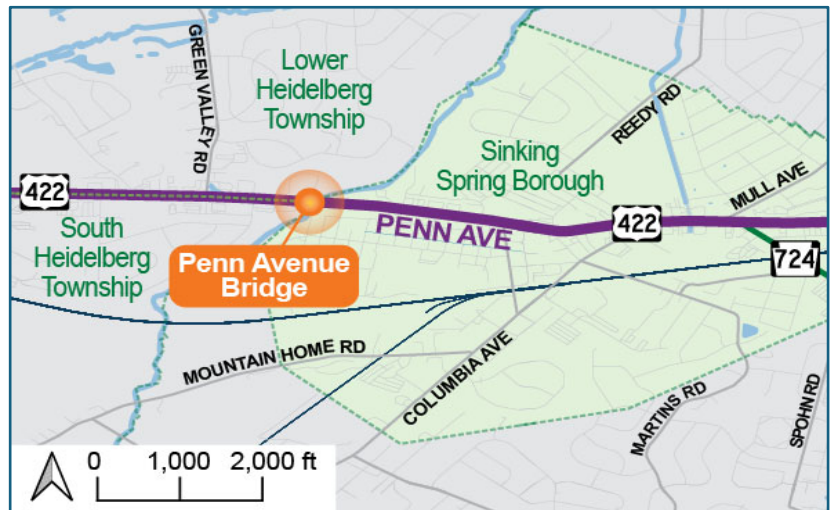

The project involves replacing the existing single-span, reinforced concrete, T-Beam structure built in 1934. The new bridge will provide a safe and efficient crossing with a structure that meets current design standards. Two lanes of traffic will remain open during construction. The estimated construction cost is \$2.5 million with construction anticipated to begin in the summer 2027.
