These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the Borough of Sinking Spring.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about August 14, 2026 the Borough of Sinking Spring will submit a request to the HUD/CPD, Congressional Grants Division for the release of Borough of Sinking Spring Central Business District Infrastructure Improvement Program funds under B-22-CP-PA-0772 of 2022, to undertake a project know as Community Project Funding for the purpose of Economic Development Initiative within the Phase 2 Final Project.

Construction of new intersections of Columbia and Krick Avenue with the connection for the new downtown retail street for development of the Central Business District. Project budget \$5,452,660.00 HUD Grant award of \$1,865,624.00. See attached documents for additional information.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICATE IMPACT

The Borough of Sinking Spring has determined that the project will have no significate impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at Office of the Borough of Sinking Spring, 3940 Penn Avenue, Sinking Spring, PA. 19608, and may be examined or copied weekdays 8A.M. to 4P.M.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the Borough of Sinking Spring. All comments received by **August 10, 2026, plus fifteen days, will be considered by the Borough of Sinking Spring prior to authorizing submission of a release of funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.**

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The Borough of Sinking Spring certifies to HUD/PA that Michael D. Hart in his capacity as Borough Manager consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the Borough of Sinking Spring to use the Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE FUNDS

HUD/PA will accept objections to its release of funds and the Borough of Sinking Spring certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Borough of Sinking Spring; (b) the Borough of Sinking Spring has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred cost or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD/PA; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Section 58.76) and shall be addressed to the Philadelphia Office of Community Planning and Development at CPDRROFPHI@hud.gov. Potential objectors should contact HUD/PA to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
